The steps for the REBEL software protocol and workflow will be demonstrated;

1. Make a very simple mock up ONLY on a CENTRAL, and make a full face picture of the patient
2. Digitally scan intra-orally and send the 3D STL file to the REBEL digital wax-up center
3. Within less than an hour the 3D STL file of the new smile design proposal will arrive
4. Then 3D printed design will be ready for next day
