Abstract

The occlusion, advanced colour theory, and choice of materials will be discussed. During the hands-on part, the participants will experience how to design different tooth preparations and provisionalization which will end with cementation.

This course is designed to elevate the skills of clinicians who already have done veneer cases in addition to building a strong base for dentists who intend on starting with veneer cases.
